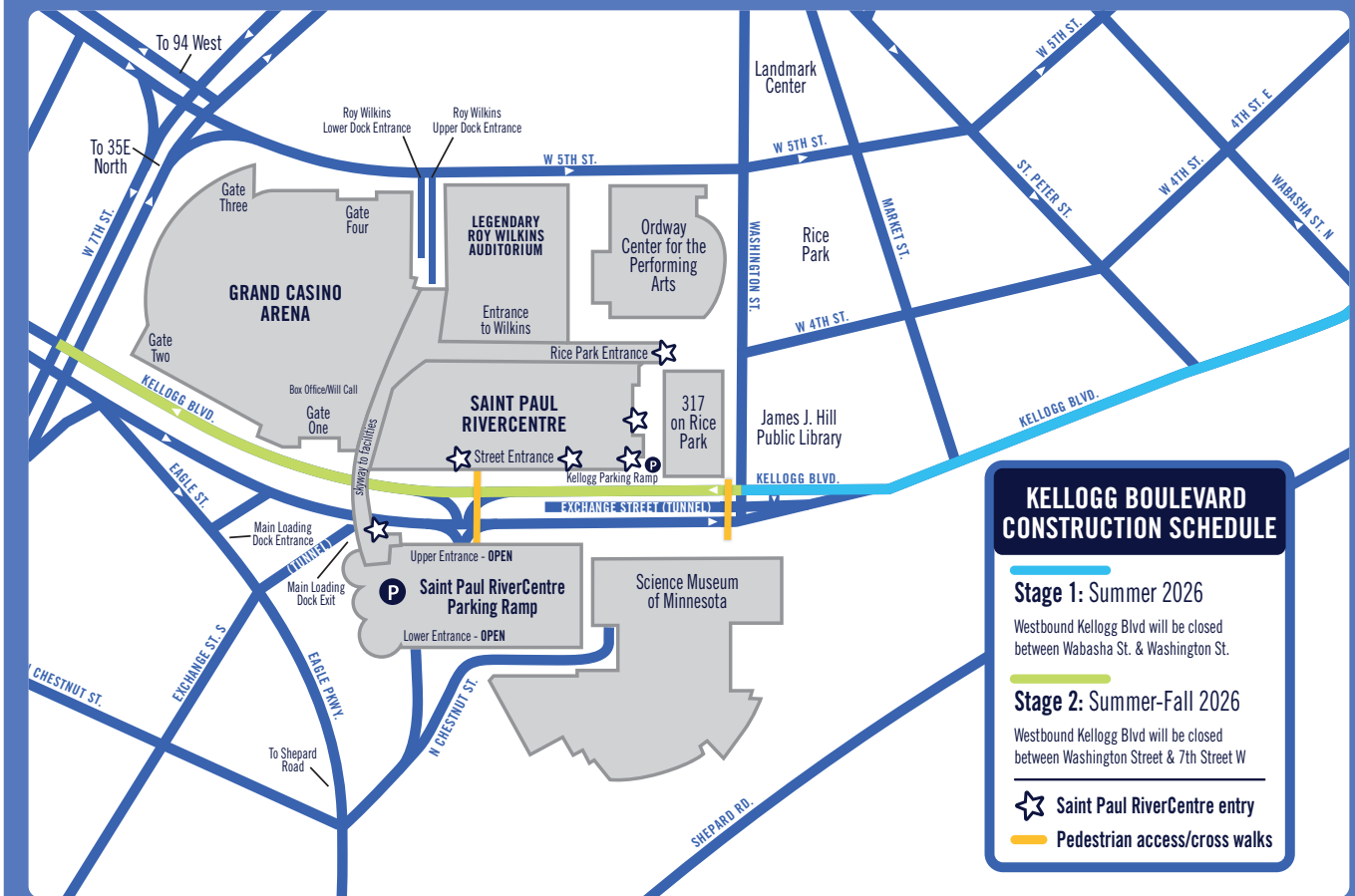


# CITY OF SAINT PAUL BIKE LANE CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW

Westbound Kellogg Blvd closed for bike lane construction from Wabasha Street to West 7th Street



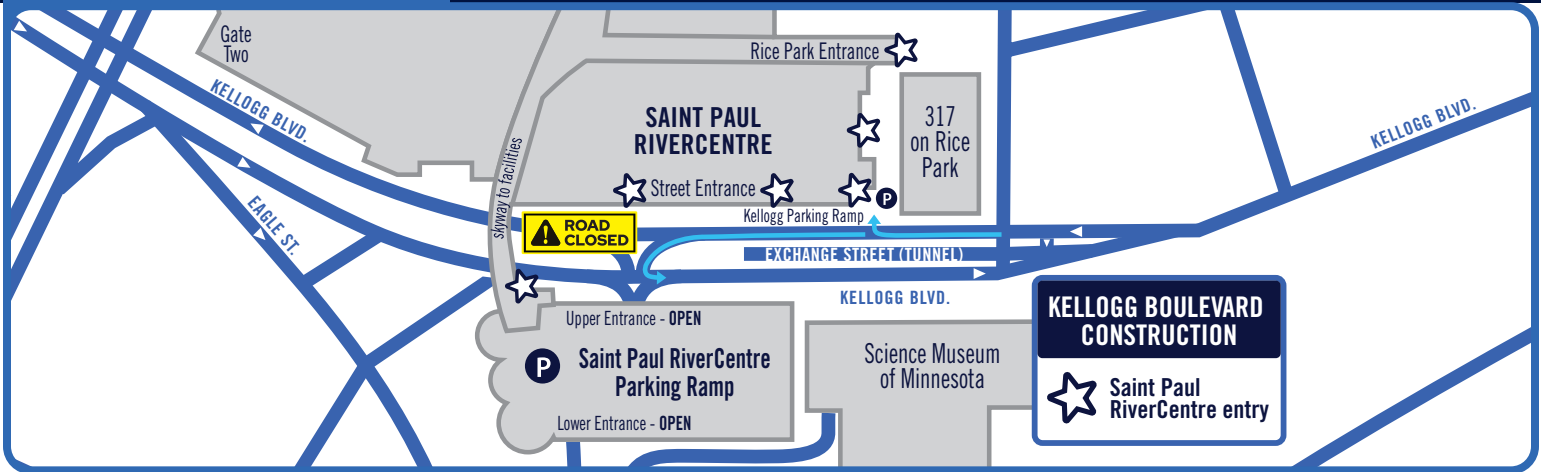
### FRONT DOOR & SIDEWALK IMPACTS:

- Curb cut on Kellogg Blvd will NOT be available for use.
- Kellogg Parking Ramp and RiverCentre Parking Ramps WILL be open.

### VENDOR LOAD-IN / LOAD-OUT:

- Vendors or exhibitors are encouraged to carry or cart their items from their vehicle.
- If a larger load-in is required, please contact your event manager for additional information.

## PARKING RAMP ACCESS



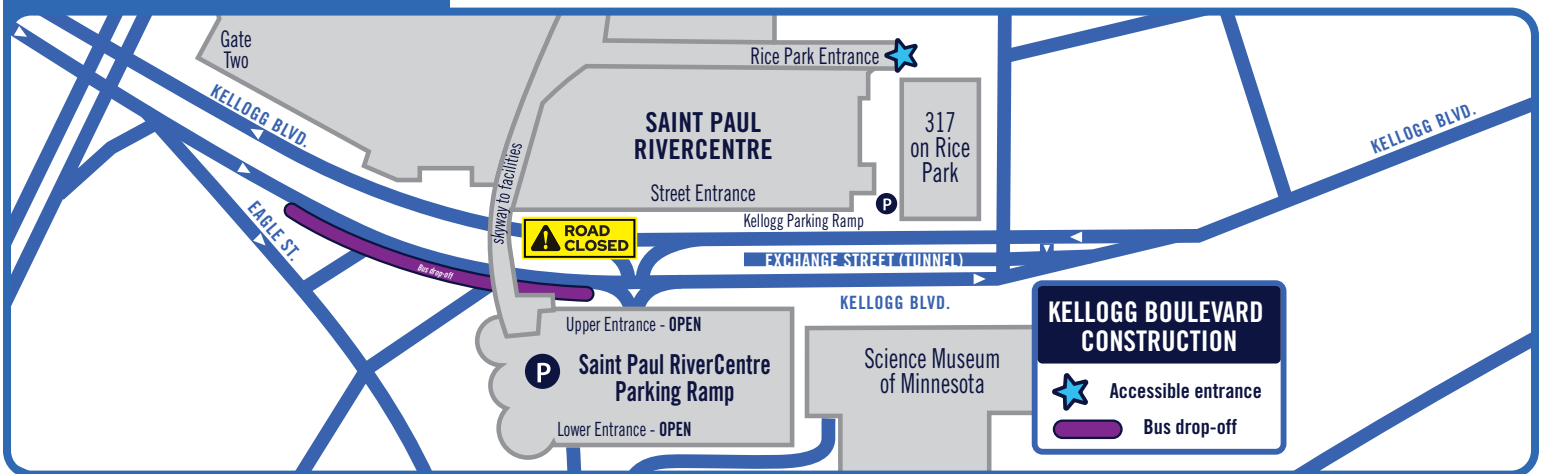
### RIVERCENTRE PARKING RAMP:

- The RiverCentre Ramp is not impacted by the bike lane construction.
- Vehicles will only be able to enter from the eastbound lanes on Kellogg Blvd and the lower entrance. Drivers will not be able to exit westbound onto Kellogg Blvd.

### KELLOGG PARKING RAMP:

- The Kellogg Parking Ramp will remain open during construction.
- Upon exit, drivers will turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. and make a U-turn at the traffic signal to travel eastbound.

## DROP-OFF LOCATIONS



### ALTERNATIVE ENTRANCE & ADA DROP-OFF:

- The Rice Park Entrance will serve as an alternative entrance and preferred ADA drop off location. This entrance is located at 111 West 4th Street (corner of Washington & 4th Street).

### BUS AND SHUTTLE

- Bus drop-off will take place on the eastbound lanes of Kellogg Blvd adjacent to the RiverCentre Parking Ramp.
- Kellogg Blvd street level doors will be closed. Guests should follow signage to enter via the RiverCentre Skyway to enter facility.

### VALET

- Contact your Event Manager for valet option details.
